Dercum's disease

Dercum's disease, also known as Adipositas dolorosa, juxta-articular adiposis dolorosa (around the knees), lipomatosis dolorosa, adiposalgia or lipalgia, is a rare condition in which painful subcutaneous lipomas or fat deposits are developed. The lipomas or fat deposits are painful to the touch but can also hurt spontaneously. The pain can be invalidating and is often difficult to treat.

The cause for the development of Dercum's disease is unknown, the pain may be caused by pressure on nerves of growing lipomas. It usually occurs in post-menopausal women (male to female ratio is 1:30) who are overweight. Dercum patients often also have other complaints such as chronic fatigue and neurological or psychiatric symptoms. The predisposition for Dercum's disease is partly genetic (presumably autosomal dominant inheritable).

At present, surgically removing the lipomas or a 'medica' liposuction of the fat deposits is the only effective treatment for removing the abnormal, painful fatty tissue. More information about the liposuction treatment can be found on our website and in the brochure 'Tumescent Liposuction'.

Reimbursement

Treatment of Dercum's disease is in principle covered by insured care, but liposuction is not always reimbursed by the health insurer. A request must be made for this.
