

## Paradoxical hyperplasia of adipose tissue

# Paradoxal hyperplasia of adipose tissue is a diagnosis that has only been around for a few years. It arises in rare cases after cryolipolysis (coolsculpting) treatments.

Cryolipolysis is a treatment that has existed for about 10 years, in which excess fat tissue is "frozen", causing fat cells to die and tissue volume to decrease. The procedure has now taken up a full place in the world of body contouring, with scientifically proven effectiveness and generally mild side effects.

With paradoxical hyperplasia we see that a few months after the cryolipolysis treatment, the fat tissue actually increases in volume instead of that it becomes less. The thickened fat tissue feels harder and is often more sensitive than the surrounding, 'normal' fat tissue. The exact cause of this reaction to cryolipolysis is still unknown. To date, there appears to be no relationship with gender, age, BMI, medication use or other existing conditions in patients. It usually occurs on the abdomen or flanks, but has also been described on the lower chin.

At the moment, a "medical" liposuction is the only effective treatment for removing the abnormal fatty tissue in paradoxal hyperplasia. More information about the liposuction treatment can be found on our website and in the brochure 'Tumescent Liposuction'.

#### Reimbursement

Treatment of paradoxical hyperplasia is not covered by insured care and is not reimbursed by the health insurer. Sometimes the treatment is reimbursed by the supplier of the cryolipolysis device.
